

Information Brochure: Admission to MBBS courses under the Management Quota for the academic year 2013-14 in Narayana Medical College, Nellore

Rules and Regulations:

Introduction:

The provisions contained in this information brochure govern the procedure for admission of students.

This information brochure is in addition to NTR University of Health Sciences stipulated regulations with all the amendments thereto, and shall be binding on all the candidates seeking admission into MBBS course.

1. The candidates seeking admission to MBBS course are required to:-

- 1) Go through Information Brochure carefully and acquaint themselves with all the rules, regulations and requirements for admission to MBBS course under the management quota.
- 2) Acquaint themselves with eligibility conditions/criteria prescribed for admission.
- 3) Application duly filled in the prescribed form, furnished along with this Information Brochure, shall be given in the office of the college and obtain receipt. Application submitted on a photocopy of application form will be summarily rejected.
- 4) Write complete address with Postal Pin Code, Telephone No., Mobile No., Email address if any, in Application Form. The candidate is required to mention in the postal address the district to which he / she belongs.
- 5) The candidates applying for admission, if found eligible, will be required to appear before Committee for interview at their own expenses at Narayana Medical College, Nellore on a date and time fixed by the college.
- 6) Selection of candidates in all the categories shall be subject to production and verification of all the relevant certificates in original.
- 7) The list of eligible candidates will be available in the office of the College for information and also available on the website (www.narayanamedicalcollege.com).
- 8) Mere figuring in the selection list will not confer any right to admission on the candidate if he / she is otherwise had committed any error / mistake / fraud / misrepresentation/ impersonation etc.
- 9) Any attempt by the candidate to secure admission through agents, by proxy and misrepresentation will automatically render him/her ineligible for admission.

2. Eligibility:

Educational Qualifications: The candidates should have passed two years Intermediate (10+2 pattern) or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and English individually and must have obtained not less than 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology. In respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes and the Backward Classes the marks obtained shall be a minimum of 40% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology. OC-PH candidates shall must have obtained not less than 45% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.

Age: The candidate should have completed the age of 17 years by 31st December, 2013.

3. Certificates to be attached along with the application.

Photostat copies of the following certificates should be attached with the filled in application form strictly in the order given below.

1. Copy of the SSC or any equivalent examination showing date of birth and other particulars of the candidate.
2. Copy of Memorandum of Marks of the qualifying examination making eligible for admission.
3. Study & Conduct Certificate
4. Transfer Certificate
5. Migration Certificate (if applicable)
6. Equivalence Certificate (if applicable)
7. Demand draft drawn on any nationalized bank in favour of Narayana Medical College for Rs. 5,000/- payable at Nellore towards application registration fee.

Documents mentioned hereunder should be submitted at the time of interview.

1. Bank Guarantee from a Nationalized Bank as a guarantee for the tuition fee for the entire course period.
2. Code of Conduct & Anti-ragging affidavit

NB: In case of non submission of any of the certificates/ documents will disqualify the candidature.

4. How to Submit

Filled in application form, complete in all respects along with all certificates / documents, shall be submitted at the college before 4.00 P.M. on 19th July, 2013 and obtain receipt.

5. Selection Procedure

The selection procedure will be as per G.O. Ms. No. 97, dated 6th July, 2013 and as per guidelines of Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

6. Fee Structure

Regarding the fee structure, the recommendations of the AFRC will be implemented as per the GO Ms. Nos. 92 of 1st July 2013.

7. General Information:

One year Compulsory Rural Service:

As per G.O. Ms. No. 166, HM & FW(E1) Dept., dated 20.07.2010, the compulsory Rural Medical/Dental services for MBBS/BDS candidates admitted from the academic year 2010-11 onwards shall be for a period of one year, immediately following the successful completion of the MBBS/BDS including the completion of house surgency. The candidates shall be called as Junior Resident during the period of one year of Rural Service. On successful completion of the one year rural Medical service, the candidate will be eligible for a permanent registration with A.P. Medical Council.

Attendance:

75% of attendance in a subject is compulsory inclusive of attendance in non-lecture teaching i.e. seminars, group discussion, tutorials, demonstrations, practicals, hospital postings, bedside clinics, failing which the student will not be permitted to appear for the University exam with his/her batch of students. Attendance shall be calculated from the total number of hours prescribed by UHS / MCI and not the number of classes conducted.

Referred students should also have 75% of attendance in both theory and practical.

Discipline:

Discipline, Code of conduct, anti-ragging regulations and MCI Code of medical ethics regulations will be supplied at the time of admission to the college.

Code of conduct, anti-ragging regulations, MCI Code of medical ethics 2002 and any such regulations are applicable to undergraduate medical students.
