Nellore town offers tourist places like

Talpagiri Ranganathaswamy Temple

The Sri Ranganthaswami Temple in Nellore, Andhra Pradesh, India is a Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Ranganatha a resting form of Lord Vishnu. This temple, also called Talpagiri Ranganathaswami temple or Ranganayakulu is one of the oldest temples in Nellore. It is located on the banks of the Penna River and is believed to have been constructed in the 12th century. Just before the main entrance of the temple is a huge tower, called Gaaligopuram, which literally means "wind tower". This tower is approximately 70 feet high and has 10 feet of gold plated vessels on top of it, called kalashams. Every year during the month of March–April (which varies according to the Indian calendar) a grand festival is celebrated. These are called Brahmotsavam.



Kotha Koduru Beach

Facing the boisterous waters of the enormous Bay of Bengal, Koduru Beach is a famous travel attraction in the district of Nellore, Andhra Pradesh. The white and golden virgin sands of the beach adorned with the rocky cliffs and towering palm trees add elegance to its appearance. Such scenic surroundings make Koduru Beach a famous and a must-visit attraction. It is visited by hundreds of visitors on a daily basis.



Jonnawada

Jonnawada is a village in Butchireddipalem mandal, located in Nellore district of the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. It is located on the banks of river Pennar. It is famous for Sri Mallikarjuna swamy and Kamakshi amma temple constructed in the year 1150. The goddess Kamakshi is believed as an incarnation of Shakti. A 'Sri Chakram' was installed here by Sri Jagadguru Adhi Sankaracharya.



Pulicat Lake

Pulicat Lake Bird Sanctuary is a famous 481 km² located in Nellore district of Andhra Pradesh and Protected area in Thiruvallur District of Tamil Nadu state in South India. Pulicat Lake is the second largest brackish-water eco-system in India after Chilka lake in Orissa. The sanctuary is most noted for the many greater flamingos seen here. The biodiversity of this lake attracts hundreds of thousands of visitors per year.



Penchalakona

Penchalakona is a village located in the Rapur Mandal of Nellore district in Andhra Pradesh, India, 70 km west of Nellore. The Penusila Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy Temple is situated at the foot of a hill in the picturesque Penchalakona Valley. There is an image of the Lord that is a representation of a self-manifested one (Swayambhu). There are two stones that are entwined to form a lion's head upon a man's body. The history of the temple is steeped in legend and its "Sthalapurana" or ancient story.



Other places of interest are **Golagamudi Venkaiah Swamy Temple**, **Kasmur Mastan Vali Dargah**, **Krishnapatnam Port**, **Nellapattu Bird Sanctuary**, **SHAR** - Sriharikota High Altitude Range, which would be a sure delight for the visitors.
