

Write up of Thesis Synopsis Orientation Programme for 1st year Postgraduates (2021-22 batch)

To enhance the quality of postgraduate dissertations, it was decided to sensitize them to biomedical research which would enhance their skills in formulating a thesis and conducting research. The programme was designed into two modules which would be conducted in a month's gap. Module-1 was a small group teaching with four lecture sessions, 45 minutes each, where the students were taught core aspects of thesis execution viz. Thesis topic selection, how to write title & objectives, types of studies and clinical trials. Three to four departments (postgraduates not exceeding 30 +/- 2) were scheduled per day so that every student gets an opportunity to actively participate in the discussions. It went on for four days- 22-6-2022 to 25-6-2022. The programme was conducted in Manthan hall, the ground floor of the medical college. Initial feedback from the students was encouraging and most of them felt the programme was useful. This programme was jointly organized by Departments of Medical Education and Community Medicine. Module-2 is planned for the last week of July-2022. Programme schedule, programme photos, and brochure are as follows.

THESIS SYNOPSIS ORIENTATION FOR 1st YEAR PGS (2021-22)

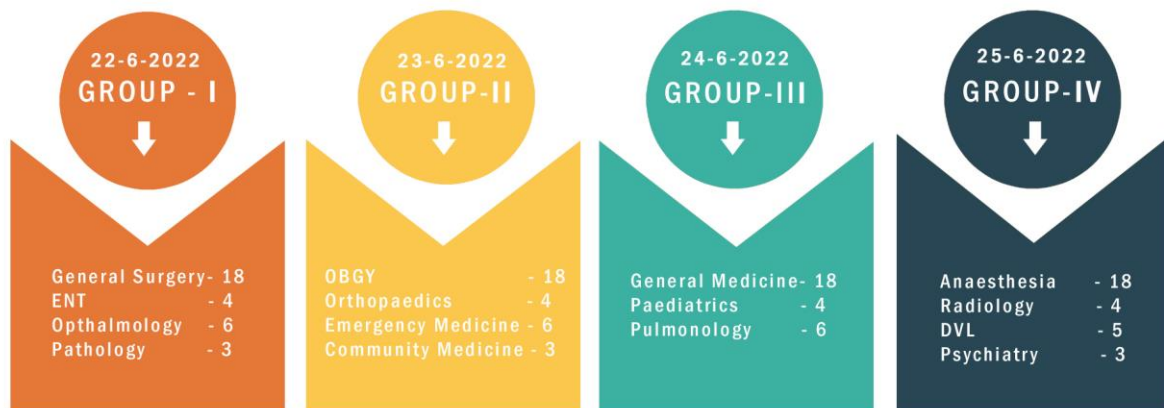
In order to sharpen the skills of the newly admitted postgraduate students, a series of hands-on-sessions are planned to assist in better quality thesis work.
