Purpose of the programme:

Medical Education Department of Narayana Medical College is organizing a series of Faculty Developing Programmes(FDP), apart from the regularly conducted Rbcw & CISP, to upskill the faculty in delivering knowledge and skills to medical students in an effective way. This is the second FDP conducted in the year 2022.

About the programme:

The programme started with the introduction of first speaker Dr.S.Venkata Venu Gopal Raju, Professor & HOD of Physiology, ASRAM, Eluru, by Dr.V.Mahidhar Reddy, MEU Coordinator, NMCH. Dr.Raju spoke about Academic Leadership in detail. Before the talk, a pretest questionnaire was given to each participant which had questions enquiring about their take on leadership. Dr.Raju,discussed the five stages of leadership and what a doctor has to do to achieve them. Various illustrations were quoted by the speaker to

emphasize the leadership stages. The talk ended with a post-test questionnaire for self assessment. Participants clarified their doubts from the speaker. Dean of NMCH, Dr.S.P.Rao gave his insights on Academic Leadership and urged the participants to ascend the stages of leadership for the betterment of them and also the institute. The speaker was felicitated by the Dean, Dr.S.P.Rao, with a shawl and by Dr.K.L.Sampath Kumar, Professor of Surgery with a Memento.

Tea break was announced for 15 minutes.

Second session of the programme started with introduction of the speaker by Dr.V.Mahidhar Reddy, MEU Coordinator, NMCH. Dr.Sushant Kumar Mishra, Professor & HOD of community medicine, GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry, is the speaker who lectured on 'Uncovering the Hidden Curriculum in Medical Education'. Soft skills pertaining to affective domain, ethics, communication skills and attitudes were discussed at length by the speaker. The speaker projected several videos of standardized patients upon whom students were practicing communication skills. Classroom activities for building soft skills in medical students were shown on prerecorded videos. At the end of the session, participants were seen having animated discussion with the speaker on ethics issues. Dean of NMCH, Dr.S.P.Rao, shared his views on the practical aspects of teaching ethics to medical students in AETCOM. Dr.Mishra was felicitated by Dr.S.P.Rao with a shawl and Dr.RamaKrishna Baru, Professor & HOD of Radiology, with a memento.
