1. Sputum of 495 TB suspects examined. 26 were +ve for AFB.
2. One patient sputum negative were diagnosed.
3.22 EPTB cases were diagnosed (Lymph node 5,Pleural 13,Abdominal 1,Others-3(Skin1,Genetic Urinary TB-2)
3. Feedback was received from all patients Quarter of 2022[POS $22 / 22$,NEG $5 / 5$,EPS $11 / 11$ ] Others-3(Skin-1,Genetic Urinary TB-2)
4. Overall performance for this quarter is good.But few suggestions to improve further and discussed
5. DTCO advised to improve gastric lavage sample particularly in paediatric TB suspects .
6. Core Coordinator Dr.K.Prasanna Purna requsted all surgical departments to send any tissue sample in NS for CBNAT to improve EPTB diagnosis.

TB Orientation programme for interns will be conducted in the coming quarter. It is agreed by all of us to improve the performance by focusing more and more on the screening and diagnosis of all types of TB, especially the EPTB.
